CoCoFe project, is almost approaching one and a half years of implementation. Its full title is: "Communicative Competency for Female Refugees on the Shop Floor: Improving communication skills in the workforce". The 5 partners who form its consortium started working on it from November 2020. The project is expected to be completed by the end of the year, in December 2022.

The coordinator of CoCoFe project is Eurospeak Language Schools from the UK. The other 4 partners are: Solution: Solidarity and Inclusion from France, Fundancion de Trabajadores de la Siderurgia Integral from Spain, Centre for Social Innovation from Cyprus and Learning for Integration from Finland.



During the first year of the project's implementation, partners worked on the Analysis of language use in small scale industries and retail employing floors female shop refugees and forced migrants. By the end of 2021, this analysis was fully developed by all partners. Eurospeak then proofread the final version and latest English bv January 2022 it was also translated into partners' national languages.







After a difficult year of travelling, due to pandemic, partners managed to meet face-toface in the lovely Paris in April 2022. That Transnational Project Meeting was hosted by Solution and partners had the chance to discuss about the second intellectual output: "Communications' Needs and a Practical Curriculum - Informal speech in factories and retail environments that will be fully uploaded on the CoCoFe e-learning platform", leaded by Eurospeak. Partners have already drafted the framework of the 10 suggested topics that will be included in the Curriculum and FTSI has also drafted a Syllabus related to this Curriculum. Beginning of the summer 2022 partners aim to have the 10 lessons fully developed together with the booklet that will include all the exercises from the e-learning platform as well as a mini dictionary of useful words and phrases to be used in the shop and manufacturing context.

In July 2022, partners have arranged to meet again face-to-face in the city of Barakaldo, in Spain.
