






## e-bulletin

And yes time is flying! CoCoFe project has entered its last month, December 2022 and it is almost completed. Its 5 partners from 5 different countries (the UK, France, Cyprus, Finland and Spain) have worked hard during these 24 months of CoCoFe's lifespan in order to produce and deliver high quality Intellectual Outcomes.

Adding up to the previous e-bulletin launched in May 2022, since then CoCoFe partners have focused on the development of the second Intellectual Output, which consists of the Companion book accompanied by a mini- dictionary and the e-learning platform of CoCoFe.

Both the companion book and the mini dictionary are available to read and download on CoCoFe's website " <a href="here">here</a> . They have also been translated from the final English version into partners' national languages, namely into French, Finnish, Greek and Spanish.

The course companion book consists of 10 lessons, which aim to help female migrants get better integrated into the society of the host country.

The topics of the lessons were chosen carefully so as to serve the target groups' needs, as seen below:













Partners will have the chance to meet face-to-face for one more time in the UK, where the final meeting will be held on the 20th and the 21st of December 2022. This will be hosted by Eurospeak and representatives from CSI, Solution, LFI and FTSI will travel to the UK to attend it.

This final meeting will allow project partners and target-group representatives to review and evaluate work, outcomes, discuss the future requirements and sustainability of CoCoFe. It will involve partners target-group representatives and mentor-group representatives.

Last but not least, it will allow project delegates to evaluate work, outcomes, discuss the future exploitation and sustainability, review impact and plan for wider impact in the future.

Discussion of lesson learned will take place and a special emphasis will be given to the Piloting held by each partner in each partner county in November 2022 and of course all partners will share their experience and feedback derived from their Multiplier Events regarding project's outcomes and especially the e-learning platform of CoCoFe.

Multiplier Events have been planned ahead of the Final Meeting and they all took place in partners' countries before the 20th of December. Partners are looking forward to meeting in the UK!
